and/or July 23-27 from 8:30 AM - 12 Noon

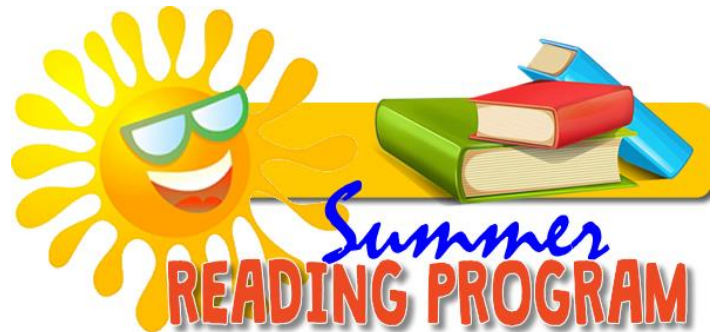
Where: St. Francis Xavier School

- This camp will include interactive group work which will focus on grammar, sentence structure, inferencing, characterization, cause and effect, and summarization.
- All students will have a personal portfolio of their work which will be updated daily to convey the skills covered in camp.
- Of course, no camping experience would be complete without games, projects, and snacks!
- This fun summer experience is limited to 20 campers.
- Students will gain much from this experience and close the summer learning gap in order to be prepared for the upcoming school year!
